Aims:

- -Jesus had a time reflection.
- -God sent the people to Him. He knew how to behave in wisdom in every situation/he separates himself by going in a ship. He sat/he rested in his ministry: he was at peace with the calling on his life.
- 'Behold'-He calls the crowds to attention. (He exercises His authority).
- When sowed! Only at the point of sowing; is there a possibility of a harvest.
Some = the percentage that fell by the way side.
- A link between the seeds by the wayside and the fowls coming to devour (no covering)
 - 'Stony'-relates to a resistance/non acceptance of Godly conditions. The resistance caused the shallowness/lack in the potential seed.

- The sun- equals defensive weapon against the seed. Because there was no depth to the seed it died.
- The seed ‘fell’ in a challenging/hostile environment.
(The thorns are a demonic assignments against believers, Oppression in the mind/broken heart/weariness)
- Good ground is a place or environment, fertile, conducive to healthy reproduction.

Launching Pad
